

# Identification: What is On and Around Your Plant

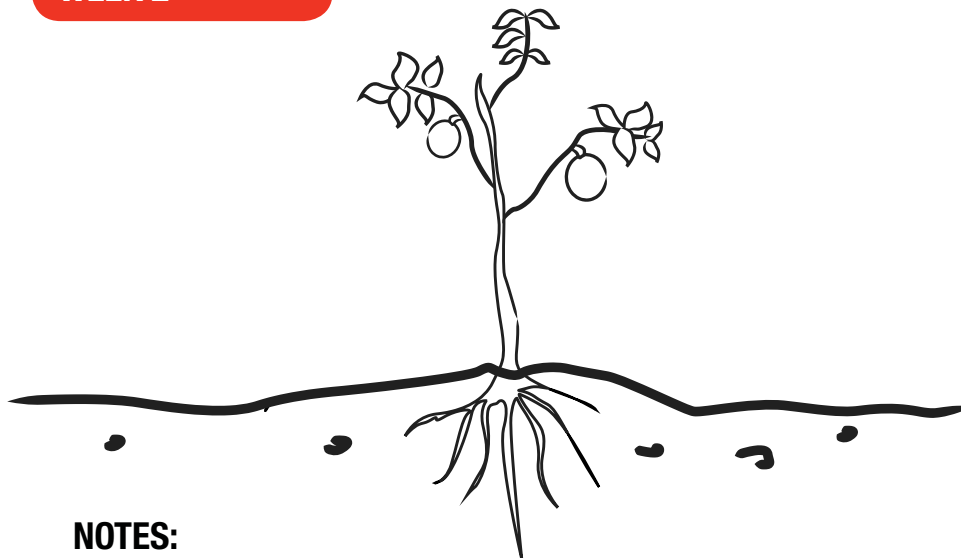
In this section you are going to check your plant and make notes about what insects are on or around it. If you don't know what the insect is, make a few notes (so you don't forget) and look it up later.

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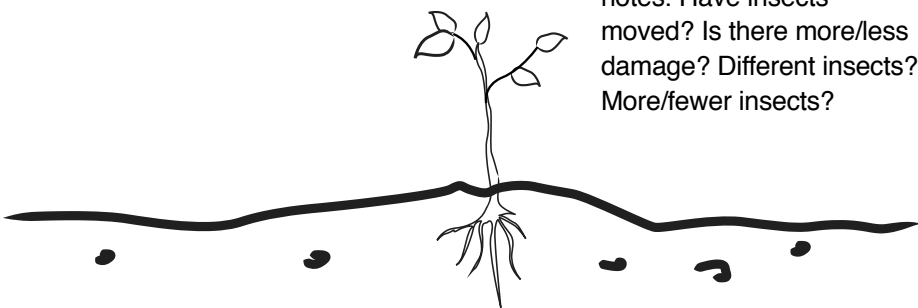

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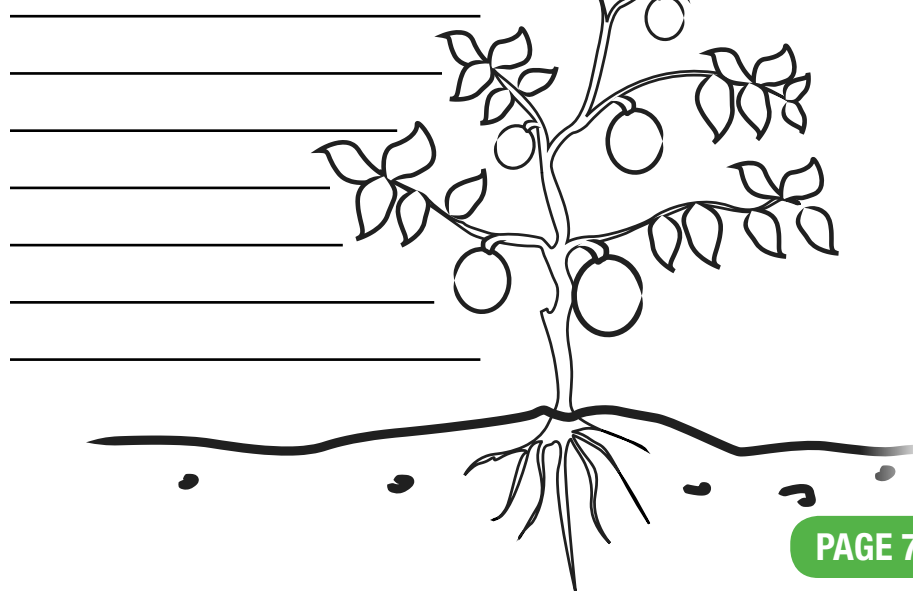
